
## a. Responses

### 1. Institution where You work:


1) Organisation providing social services:

The area that we cover is mainly the disable people (9 from 20), and 3(from 20) of them were in an institute where they have all categories.


- 2) Children's educational institution;

Only 4 Children educational institutions were involved in the research, and 4 Non-Governmental the rest were Government.


### 2. You are:

9 responders were social workers, only 2 were social workers helper's and 2 were teachers.


## 3. Your work experience: ..... (years).




Most of them are involved with mental disability (55%), follow are with complex disability (25%) and blind disability (10%).











Most of them worked (8/26) organise guide activities and from this category 37% prefer art therapy.
















Answer "YES" 17 (or 85%), "I do not know" 3 (or 15%) and "NO" absolutely 0.








